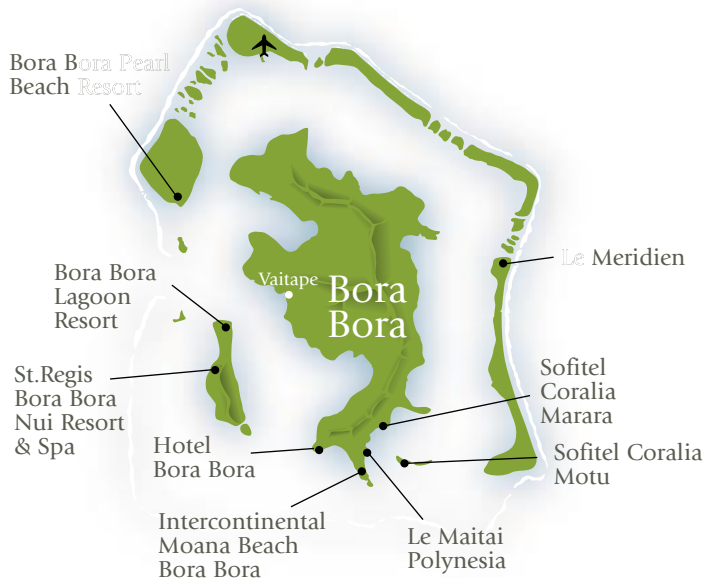




Bora Bora

Located on the tip of Motu Toopua, in the middle of Bora Bora's magnificent lagoon, and commanding breathtaking views of Mt. Otemanu, this award-winning Orient Express Hotel offers 80 elegantly traditional bungalows in garden, beach and overwater settings. Each air-conditioned bungalow features separate bathroom with shower and tub, TV with DVD, mini-bar, IDD telephones and outdoor decks - Overwater bungalows offer glass-topped coffee tables for lagoon viewing.

Bora Bora Pearl Beach Resort

Located on the motu of Teveiroa, the largest of the islets surrounding Bora Bora lagoon, the Pearl Beach Resort blends into the natural environment. The resort features 50 overwater bungalows and 10 beach bungalows with garden bathrooms and Jacuzzis and 20 garden pool suites. Room facilities include air conditioning (beach bungalows and garden pool suites only), ceiling fans (overwater bungalows), large outdoor terrace, private bathroom with shower, direct dial telephone, and tea/coffee making facilities.

RESORT FACILITIES include 2 restaurants and bar, activities desk. Activities include swimming pool, snorkelling, kayaking, outrigger canoes, shark-feeding, scuba diving, circle island tours, glass bottom and sunset cruises.

Le Meridien

Le Meridien is located on a 10km motu islet 20 minutes by boat from the Bora Bora airport. The resort offers 85 overwater bungalows and 15 beach bungalows. Room facilities include ceiling fans, air conditioning, separate bathtub and shower, tea/coffee making facilities direct dial telephone and personal safe. In the overwater bungalows you can also watch the underwater world through a large windowed surface in the living room floor.

RESORT FACILITIES include 2 restaurants and bar, spa, activities desk, swimming pool and Turtle Sanctuary. Activities include canoes, snorkelling equipment, scuba diving, deep sea fishing, and shark feeding excursions.

Intercontinental Moana Beach Bora Bora
