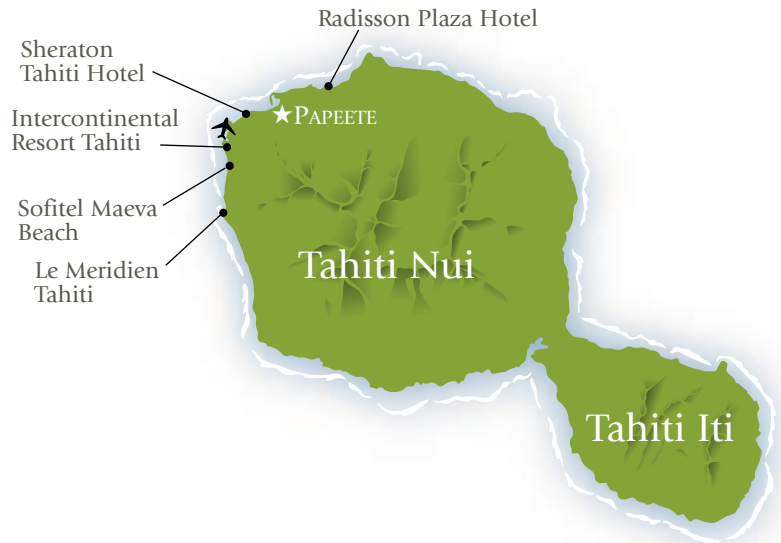


# Tahiti

## ACCOMMODATION SELECTIONS

### Radisson Plaza Resort

From CAD\$147 PER PERSON

Located on the sunny north west coast of Tahiti, the resort is a convenient 10-minute drive from Tahiti's Faaa International Airport and 4.5 miles from Papeete's shopping district.

The resort comprising of 165 guest rooms including 85 ocean view rooms, is set amidst four acres of tropical gardens and features stunning views over Matavai Bay. Room features include large covered balconies, open style bathrooms, air-conditioning, tea/coffee making facilities and a selection of rooms feature Jacuzzis or kitchenettes.

## Intercontinental Resort Tahiti

From CAD\$169 PER PERSON

This luxury resort nestles in 15 acres of lush tropical gardens on the sunny western shore of Tahiti, with magnificent views of the island of Moorea. Built in Polynesian style the resort comprises of 172 rooms with private balcony, 60 panoramic view rooms, 17 overwater bungalows grouped around a private island and 15 overwater bungalows built out over the lagoon. Room facilities include air conditioning, private balcony, and complimentary tea/ coffee making facilities.

RESORT FACILITIES include two restaurants, one overwater by the lagoon next to the white sand bottom swimming pool, two large freshwater swimming pools, scuba diving and snorkelling, sunset cruises, and Tahitian dance shows 3 evenings per week.

## Le Meridien Tahiti

From CAD\$183 PER PERSON

Located 9 km from the Tahiti Faa International Airport and 15 km from downtown Tahiti, this world-class resort offers stunning views of the lagoon. The 130 rooms, all with ocean views, and 12 overwater bungalows are designed to emphasize the Polynesian setting. Room facilities include air conditioning, personal safe, direct dial telephone, tea and coffee making facilities, cable TV, separate bath tub and shower.

RESORT FACILITIES include 2 restaurants and 2 bars. Activities include sand bottom swimming pool, canoes, snorkelling equipment, and scuba diving.



## Sheraton Tahiti Hotel

From CAD\$169 PER PERSON

The Sheraton Tahiti Hotel is situated on a tranquil lagoon with panoramic views of Papeete harbor and the island of Moorea. Each of the 200 rooms reflects a Tahitian sense of design and are fully air-conditioned. Additional room facilities include ceiling fans, in room safe, tea and coffee making facilities, private bathroom with bathtub and shower, private balcony and direct dial telephone.

RESORT FACILITIES include restaurant, coffee shop and bar, activities center. Activities include swimming pool, health club, and snorkelling equipment, scuba diving and water sport program

## Sofitel Maeva Beach

From CAD\$95 PER PERSON

Located in the midst of a lush tropical garden bordering a tranquil lagoon 5 minutes from Tahiti Faa International Airport and 10 minutes from downtown Papeete. Situated on a white sand beach and lagoon the hotel has 224 air conditioned rooms with private balconies. Additional room facilities include private bathroom with bathtub and shower, direct dial telephone, and tea and coffee making facilities

RESORT FACILITIES include 2 restaurants and bar, activities desk, swimming pool, 2 flood lit tennis courts, and a solarium on the beach. Pay activities include scuba diving, deep-sea fishing, sunset cruises, windsurfing and water skiing.
